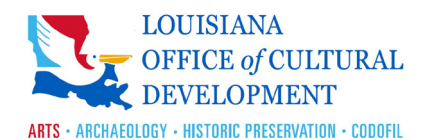
To register, visit our event calendar and scroll to the program date, January 25. From there you can click "Page Meets Stage Reading and Discussion Group" and fill out our registration form.
